District of Columbia High School to Implement Visitor Verification Process upon Entering School

New system to go live at Ballou High School in September to increase security of its buildings and manage visitors; cross checks against National Sex Offenders Registry

October 5, 2007 – YORK, PENNSYLVANIA – Access411 today announced that Ballou High School, part of the District of Columbia Public Schools, will implement Visitor Pass Plus, a new system designed to record and verify the identities of visitors. Ballou High School implemented Access411's award-winning software solution, Comprehensive, Attendance, Administration, and Security System (CAASS), last year with great success and is expanding Access411's offerings with Visitor Pass Plus.

Ballou High School, in South East, DC, has an enrollment of over 1,000 students and will be using Visitor Pass Plus for the identity verification and recording of all visitors, including volunteers. Visitor Pass Plus starts with scanning of a visitor's driver's license or state issued photo identification cards. The system will produce an updated photograph of the visitor and capture the visitor's signature for an additional layer of security. Visitor Pass Plus ties into the CAASS System, which stores legal parent and guardian information for each student. If the visitor is at the school for business other than to release a student, Visitor Pass Plus will record their organization name or affiliation and with whom they have an appointment. Prior to printing the visitor badge, Visitor Pass Plus can process a look-up against the National Sex Offender's Registry if the administrator chooses. Lastly, Visitor Pass Plus will print out a visitor's badge on an adhesive label that may or may not have time expiration. All the information about each visitor is stored within a database and Visitor Pass Plus comes complete with a variety of automatic reports to identify any major red flags in the visitor logs.
